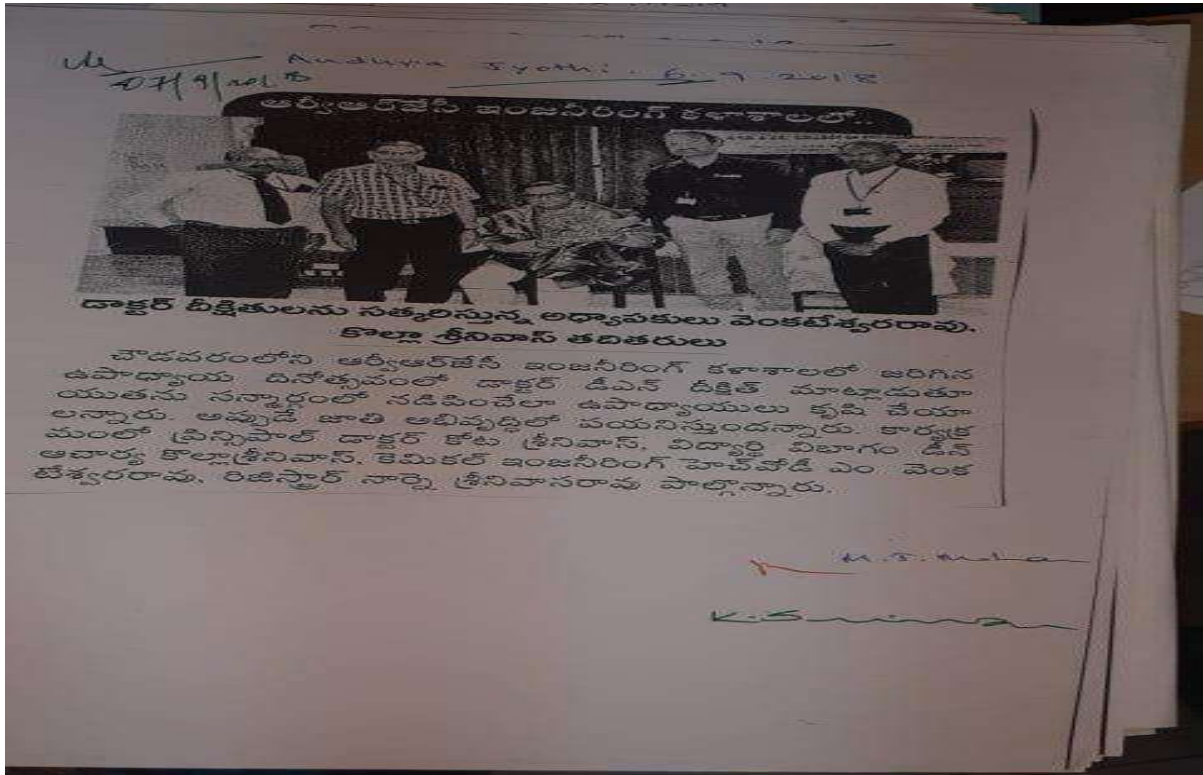
Title of Activity:International Women’s Day
